- g. Fort Bend County Bellaire Boulevard right turn lane project;
- h. deeds, easements, appraisals, consents to encroachment, encroachment agreements, assignments of capacity, requests for service, utility conveyances, out-of-district service agreements, utility commitment letters, Phase I inspections, and conveyances of District property;
- i. storm water permitting matters, including educational materials and public comments;
- j. geotechnical survey for area between Lost Creek Detention Ponds B and C;
- k. Geographic Information System, including proposal from Quiddity; and
- 1. Fort Bend County sound wall installation project.
