

NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 50

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 50 (the "District") will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, July 1, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Guadalupe Conference Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive comments from the public.
2. Presentation from Fort Bend County Commissioner Precinct 4 regarding potential county partnerships.
3. Approve minutes of prior meetings.
4. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
5. Conduct public hearing regarding District's tax rate for Defined Area No. 1 (Blue Creek Trails), adopt Order Levying Taxes, and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form.
6. Discuss Association of Water Board Directors summer conference, approve reimbursement of eligible expenses, and authorize attendance at winter conference.

 - b. Agreement for Bookkeeping Services.
8. Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2026, including:

 - b. engage rating company to perform credit rating analysis for Series 2026 Unlimited Tax Bonds.
 - c. appoint Paying Agent/Registrar.
 - d. authorize advertisement for sale of the Series 2026 Bonds and schedule bond sale; and
 - e. engage auditor to prepare developer reimbursement report.

10. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.

 - c. review bids and award contracts for construction of facilities in the service area;
 - d. approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, for projects in the service area, including:
 - i. water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Pacific Peek, Ltd. (District West mixed use development);

 - iv. generators at District lift station nos. 2 and 4;

 - f. 1.7-acre tract at Beechnut and Skinner Lane.

19. Report on maintenance of District detention ponds, facility sites, and other property, including:
- a. proposals for additional maintenance; and
 - b. proposals for water quality and fountain management services.

Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation or a settlement offer; Section 551.072, Texas Government Code, to deliberate regarding real property; Section 551.076, Texas Government Code, to deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices; or Section 551.087, Texas Government Code, the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect.
